Low Cost Spay/Neuter for Cats

February is Spay/Neuter Awareness Month and in recognition of International Spay Day, the Humane Society of Southern Wisconsin will be offering spay/neuter services for cats to the public on Monday, February 21st. Cost is \$65 (+tax) per cat and drop-off will be at the shelter between 7-8 AM.

Pick up will also be at the shelter between 4:30-5:30 PM on the same day. All cats must have a current rabies vaccination or purchase the vaccination that day. All cats must come and leave in a separate carrier. FVRCP vaccines are available for free!

Appointments can be scheduled online starting Monday, February 14th at 11 AM. Spots are limited to 45 cats (30 females and 15 males).
