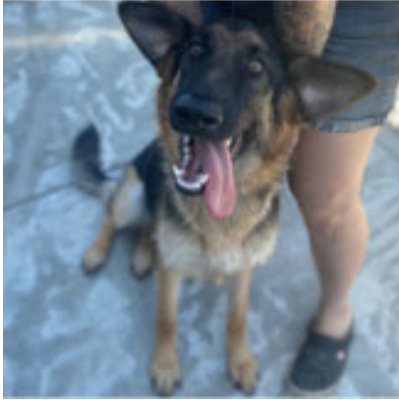
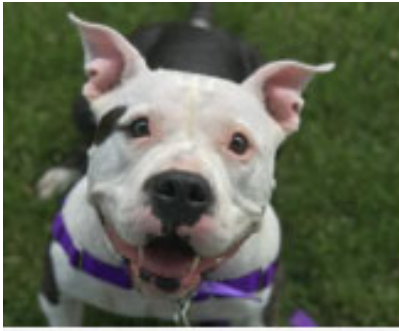

Pet CPR and First Aid Certification Class

Learn to Save the Life of a Pet

Learn Pet CPR and Support HSSW!

On Saturday, July 23rd from 1-4 PM, The Thinking K9 will offer a class and fundraiser for HSSW, designed to teach participants how to administer emergency CPR and first aid to an animal until veterinary care is ascertained.

Skills and topics covered include:

- safety skills when working with sick and/or injured animals
- emergency triage and assess if an animal is experiencing a life-threatening medical emergency
- restraining and properly transporting sick and/or injured animals
- emergency first aid for dogs and cats en route to veterinary care
- vital signs and determining normal versus abnormal readings
- learn how to use materials in the pet first aid kit
- provide first aid for many common medical emergencies such as severe wounds, poisoning, parasites, choking and more
- perform the most current industry-standard method of cardiopulmonary resuscitation on dogs and cats (participants will receive a PetCPR+ certification valid for 2 years)

Registration fee is \$74.95 and includes:

- an official certificate
- a two-year subscription to the online Animal Emergency Resource Center
- the 88-page full color class manual
