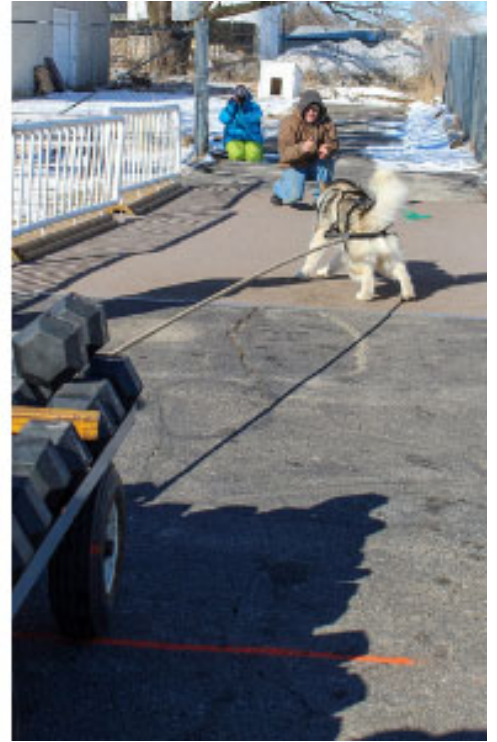
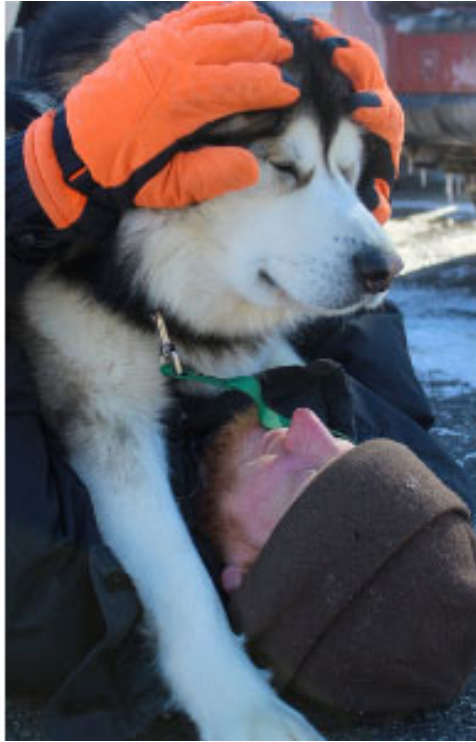

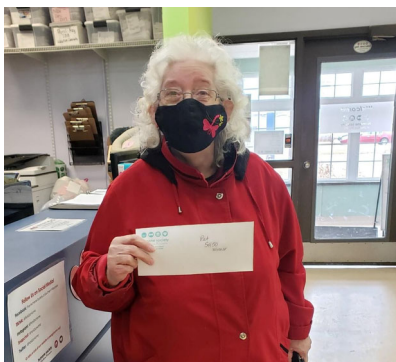

Thank You for a Wonderful Pooch Pull!

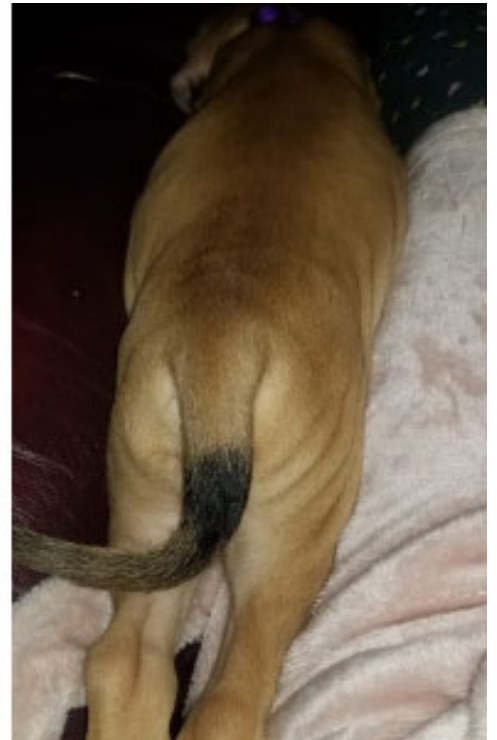

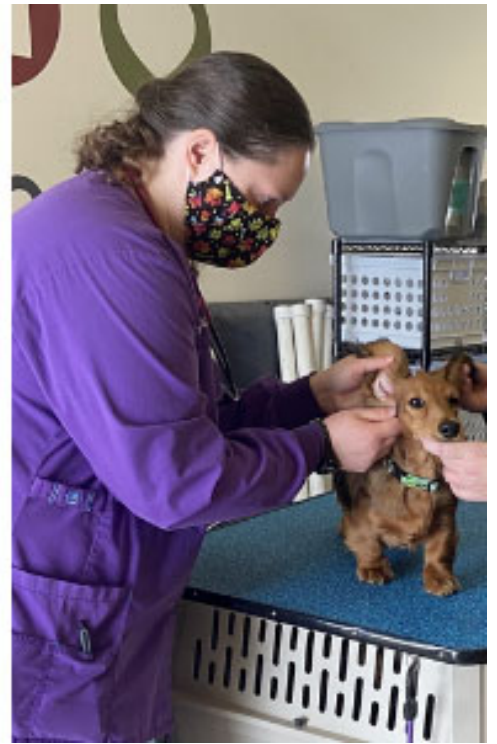
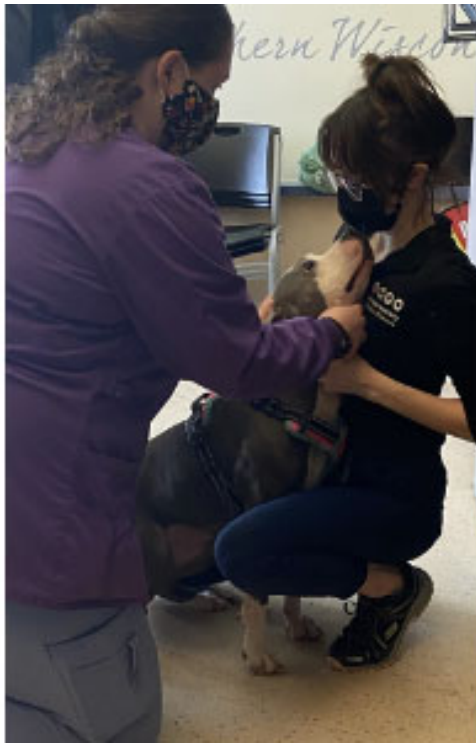


A Successful Yappy Hour!

Veterinary Services Continue to Expand

Exciting changes are happening at HSSW and this includes our veterinary services! We have recently expanded the public vaccine clinics to include a wellness clinic option, offering nail trimming, heartworm testing, deworming and more. With 3 part-time veterinarians and one relief vet on staff, public spay/neuter clinics for cats have become more of a focus in an effort to keep populations controlled.

Once settled in the new location, veterinary staff plan to expand wellness and vaccine clinics with an exam room especially for these services. More public surgery days for cats and dogs will also be offered, along with the ability to perform x-rays!

"Our goal is to also partner with a group of vets/vet students to provide large spay/neuter clinics to the public on weekends (maybe 3 or 4 per year), where the vets and students will donate their time," said Janean Boss-Anderson, Operations Director/CVT.

Another goal is to perform spay/neuter services via transport at partner locations, so they don't need to come to our location.
