Home to Home allows pet owners to rehome their animals independently online while being directly involved in the entire process. It reduces stress on pets by keeping them out of the shelter and allows potential new owners a chance to learn more about the animals directly. It also leaves more shelter resources




Spay/Neuter Day for Dogs!

Now that we are settled into our new location and have more space, we are excited to start providing spay/neuter services for dogs! On Wednesday, November 9th, HSSW will offer these low-cost services to the public: \$115 for male dogs and \$120 for females. Proof of an up-to-date rabies vaccination is required, otherwise a vaccine can be provided that day for \$10. Free DA2PP vaccines are also available, thanks to Petco Love. Additional services such as deworming, microchips and pre-anesthetic bloodwork can be added for an additional cost upon scheduling an appointment online.

Appointments will be available starting November 1st with only 10 slots available. Appointments fill up quick – so don't delay!





Rockvale Cats Spay/Neuter Day

In an effort to control the cat population, HSSW will be providing a free spay and neuter day on November 17th for all residents of the Rockvale Trailer Park. Rabies and distemper vaccinations will also be provided along with an ear tip. Flea/tick treatment and deworming can also be added upon request. Residents must provide proof of living in Rockvale Trailer Park and are responsible for pickup and drop-off on the day of surgery.

Did you know? Not only does spaying/neutering control overpopulation and help prevent the spread of disease, but mating behavior such as yowling, spraying and fighting stop!
