HSSW is partnering with **Skelly's Farm Market** to offer a beautiful and delicious 5k and 1-mile run/walk!

On Saturday, August 3rd, participants of all ages will have the opportunity to race or mosey through Skelly's 6-acre sunflower field, scenic nearby roads, and strawberry beds, with an apple cider donut waiting at the finish line. Well-behaved, leashed dogs are welcome!

Registration is \$50 and includes a race bib with time tracking, admission to the sunflower field, and an apple cider donut. Race T-shirts will be available for purchase with proceeds benefiting HSSW's mission of helping pets going home again.

A significant portion of ticket sales will also benefit HSSW, as well as \$1 from every non-race participant sunflower field admission that day!

As you know, we have had HOT temperatures this summer It is important to consider how your doggo feels in the extreme heat. Remember - if it is hot for you, it is even hotter for your

furry friend. Never leave your pet in a parked car! We know this should be common sense for pet owners at this point, but unfortunately,

hundreds of dogs still die every year from being left inside parked cars. Did you know the temperature inside your car can rise 20 degrees in just ten minutes? A cracked window DOES NOT keep the car cool enough for your pet. Keep the car running with air conditioning

especially important to monitor them.

on or leave your dog at home. Take your pet to the vet! A vet checkup is always a good idea, but especially at the beginning of the hot summer months. This checkup should include a heart-worm test and a flea and tick protection plan. These are year-round issues but in the summer months, with much more outdoors time, it's

Avoid the heat, bring plenty of water! - Any outdoor exercise should be limited to the cooler parts of the morning and evening. - Collapsible travel water bowls are a good way to make sure your pet stays hydrated on hot days!

- Put the back of your hand on any asphalt you are about to walk your dog on. If you can't keep it there for five seconds, it is too hot for your pup's feet. Try putting booties on your dog

to insulate against dangerous hot pavement. Is your dog overheating? Know the signs! -Heavy panting

-Increased drooling -Deep and rapid breathing -Glassy eyes

Is your cat overheating? Know the signs!

-Dry or pale gums


-Restless behavior as they try to find a cool spot -Panting, sweaty feet, drooling, excessive grooming in an effort to cool off -Rapid pulse and breathing -Redness of the tongue and mouth

-Vomiting -Lethargy -Stumbling, staggering gait

-Rectal temperature is over 105° F




The Cat-R-Walking Home Fund




partner was GR's Sandwich Shoppe who donated 20% of proceeds from orders on July 17th






