



### **Total Live Animal Admission**


#### **Animals Admitted**

During 2018, 3,207 animals were admitted. Of the 3,207 animals taken in, 38.82% were dogs and 60.64% were cats. Other intakes (.53%) were other pets, primarily domestic rabbits.





There was a decrease in overall admission from 2017, which was 4,164 animals. This was due to a more controlled intake process, primarily with surrendered pets and reported strays during our peak months.


#### **Sheltered Dog Outcomes**




#### **Sheltered Cat Outcomes**






#### **Clinic Services**

In 2018, the Humane Society of Southern Wisconsin further expanded its Clinic Services. In 2017, HSSW partnered with two cat rescue groups to provide low-cost veterinary and surgical services; in 2018, HSSW partnered with 11 pet rescues. Additionally, in October of 2018, HSSW started offering spay & neuter services to the public, one day a week.

There were 3,048 animals spayed or neutered by the shelter's medical team. Of the total spay/neuter surgeries, 1,366 were HSSW's shelter pets, 1,373 were pets belong to partnering rescues, and 309 were pets belonging to the public.
