Spring Online Auction Wraps up on SATURDAY!

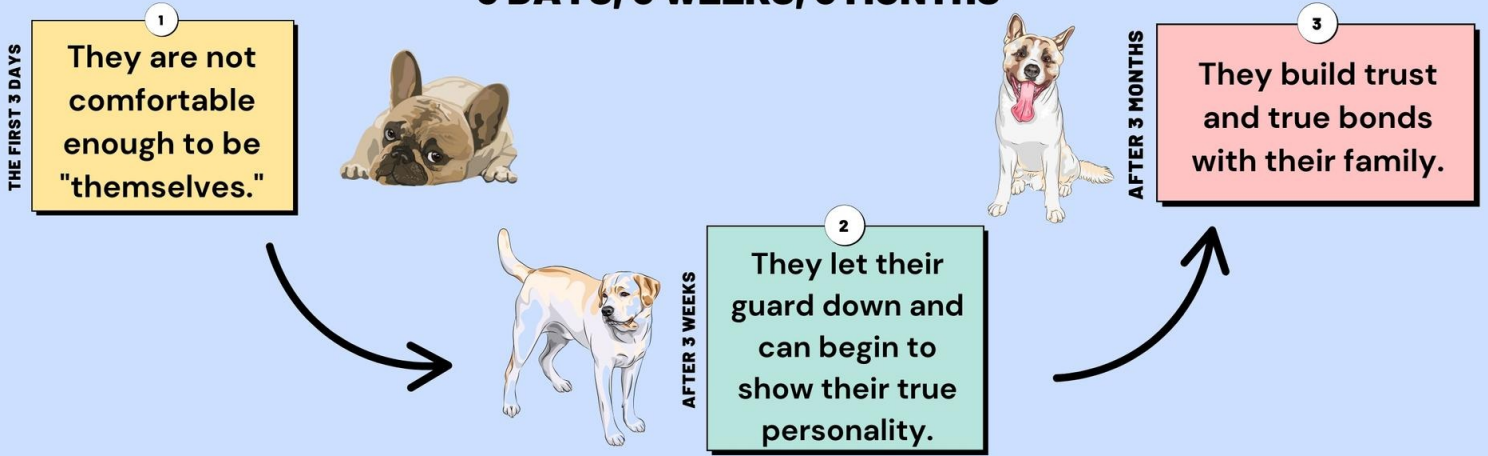
We have had a ton of great items come our way recently, so we decided to put on a Spring Auction online!

The 'Rule of Three' When Adopting

When welcoming a new dog into your home, it's important to remember 'The Rule of Three' as they settle in.

This 'Rule' helps us to know what to expect when adopting a dog and reminds us to have patience with our newly adopted friends and ourselves. It's a big transition for all of us and while it is a happy and exciting time, it is still a lot of change for the whole family.

In the first three days, your new addition may be overwhelmed and shut down. They may not be interested in eating or comfortable enough to be themselves.

After three weeks, they begin to settle in, learn their routine, let their guard down, and show their personality more. You may also notice some unwanted behaviors as they begin to test their boundaries.

After three months, they are much more settled in, comfortable, and trusting of their new family. They are bonding to you, they begin to feel secure with you, and they are much more set in their routine.

Thank You, Daniels Sentry Food!

Johnnie is giving a big ol' WOO-HOO to [Daniels Foods Sentry](#) for an amazing donation they dropped off for our pets this week. And when we say big, we mean BIG!! In total: 36 bottles of Fabulosos, 42 bottles of bleach, 72 jars of peanut butter, 72 cans of wet dog food, 84 cans of wet cat food and 30 bags of treats!! So PAWSome!

The items donated by Sentry are some of our top needed items and here's why:

- We use approx. 3 bottles of Fabulosos a week to help clean our drains in our kennels
- We use approx. 5 bottles of bleach a week on shelter laundry
- Intake & Enrichment needs about 2-4 jars of peanut butter a week for meds, Kong's and more
- Our dog care staff go through over 18 cans of wet dog food A DAY!
- While our cats go through 1 can of wet cat food (per cat that needs it) per day! Right now, that's around 30 cans A DAY!

Not all our cats get wet food, but we do use it for picky eaters, scared kitties, nursing mothers, cats with a kitty cold or for weight gain (among other reasons)

You can see how quickly we can go through things around here. That is why Johnnie and all his friends here at HSSW are so grateful for such an amazing community partner!

Donating stocks allows you to avoid capital gains tax and often take a charitable deduction for the full value of the asset. Use [this tool](#) to donate stock so we can track your gift, send you the correct receipt, and you can get the tax savings you deserve.

If you are 70.5 or older, **giving from your IRA** can help reduce your taxable income — and for those over 73 who must take a Required Minimum Distribution (RMD), an IRA gift is a simple way to fulfill it!

Donor-Advised Funds (DAFs) are investment accounts for the sole purpose of supporting charitable organizations today. Using this [Donor-Advised Fund link](#) automatically links with your DAF, allows you to recommend how you'd like your gift to be used, and notifies HSSW of your intentions.

We now accept donations of **Ethereum, Bitcoin, and other cryptocurrencies!** This gives us one more way to fund our work and can provide you with extra tax benefits.

Cats N' Mats - May 17th

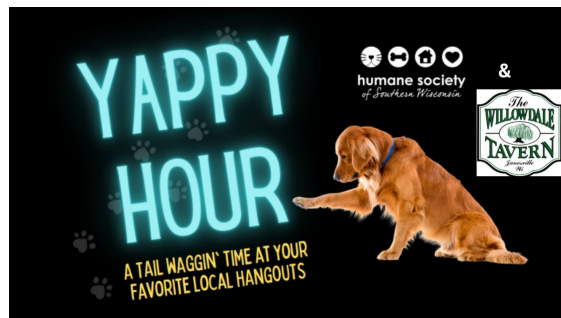


Join HSSW for a morning yoga practice lead by [Lifestyle Focus Fitness](#) and featuring adoptable cats!
