Thanksgiving is so close, we can almost taste it! We hope you have a wonderful safe Thanksgiving, but here are some things to remember in order to keep our pets safe on turkey day.

1. Be careful what you feed your pets this holiday! If you plan to give your pet a treat, be sure to stick to the pet safe options and only give a small bite size piece in order to avoid a trip to the vet.
2. If you are hosting Thanksgiving this year, be sure to have a safe space away from the crowds of guests for your pet to retreat to if they are feeling overwhelmed.
3. It's always good to make sure that your pet has the proper identification in case they slip out while people are coming in and out of the house. Ensure they have a collar that fits them well with an ID tag and update your pets microchip!
4. Be sure to take out the trash or keep it tucked out of your pets reach to avoid your furry friend from helping themselves to leftovers.
