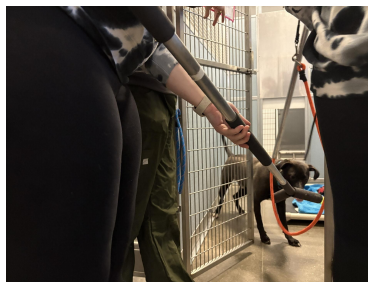
The four pets pictured are Shadow, Slim Shady, Tango, and Katie all with a unique story and a happy ending. Shadow came to us in fall of 2025 after running freely in a corn field for several months (and evading capture at every turn). Once at HSSW, it took some time for Shadow to trust us, but once we had gained that trust everything changed for her. She started going on [Doggy Day Outs](#), hanging out in the office, and just having a better time at HSSW. Yet, she remained un-adopted - until now!

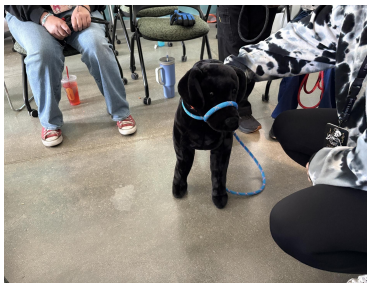
Slim Shady first came to us in the summer of 2025 and was a fast staff-favorite. He got to spend lots of time out of his kennel and exploring the property during his stay with us. Our Spring Online Auction was full of a little bit of everything and there were a few bidding wars over all the goodies! These auctions are a great way to take things that we have received, but cannot use to care for our pets, to good use. *Together, we raised over \$1,500!*

At the 50/50 Fundraiser, our volunteers and a four-legged friend named Texas, spent the day chatting and hanging out with everyone at the Turtle Tap. *And together, we raised just over \$200!*

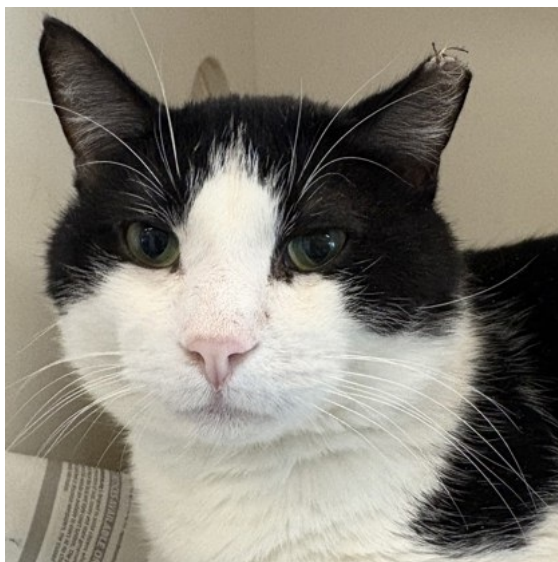
