We Need to Talk About Parvo & Panleuk.

Let's talk about Parvo & Panleuk! (Not a fun topic, we admit, but an important one!)

1. What are Parvo and Panleuk?

Parvo is short for Parvovirus and Panleuk is short for Panleukopenia. They are similar diseases that dogs and cats can contract. Parvo is in dogs and Panleuk is in cats. The diseases are serious and often fatal AND preventable!

2. How do I prevent these diseases?

The best way to prevent your pet from contracting these diseases is to vaccinate them against the diseases. For dogs, this means getting and staying up-to-date with a DA2PP vaccine. For cats, this means getting and staying up to date with an FVRCP vaccine.

3. What if my pet has one of these diseases? Or has had it before?

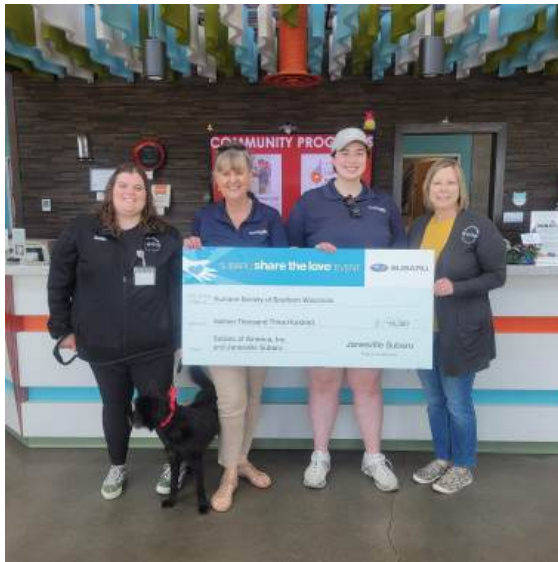
Still vaccinate them! It's not too late for you to get them vaccinated and keep them up-to-date! We have had pets at HSSW come in with these diseases and beat them through vaccination and supportive care. Vaccinating while the pet is battling the disease can help them fight through it. And keeping them vaccinated prevents them from getting it again or if they do get it again, it helps them to fight it off faster.

4. Can HSSW help me get my pet vaccinated?

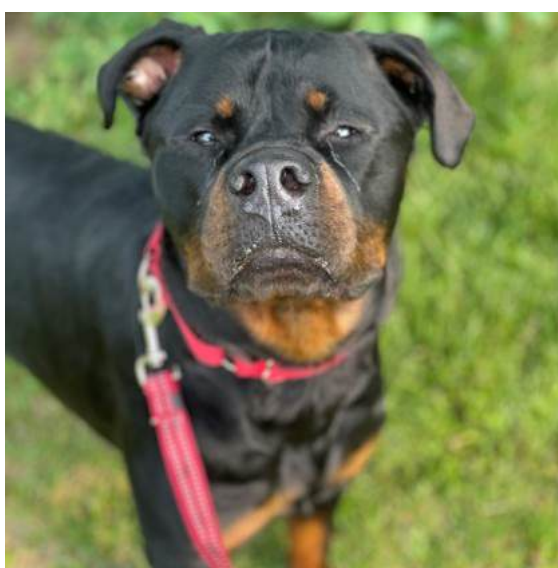
